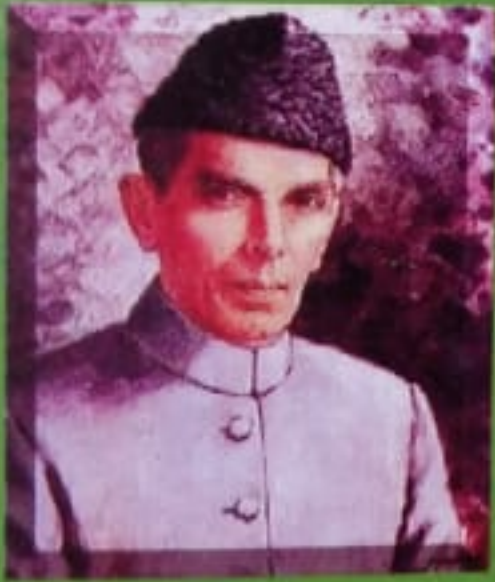


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Ahmadis are Non-Muslims

A sect that called themselves Ahmadis or Qadianis claimed to be the part of the Muslim Umma. They claimed that they are only a sect like other sects and are as good Muslims as the others are because they believe in the Prophet-hood of Muhammad (ﷺ). But after thorough discussions and research they admitted in the Assembly Session before the whole nation that they believe in the Prophet-hood of another man Mirza Ghulam Ahmad of Qadiyan. Who came after the Prophet Muhammad (ﷺ). At this they were excluded from the pale of Islam unanimously. They are non-Muslims like the other non Muslim communities in Pakistan. Every Muslim is bound to take an oath that he does not believe in any Prophet after Hazrat Muhammad (ﷺ).

Faith in the finality of Prophet hood

It is the injunction of the Constitution of 1973 that only that person is a Muslim who believes in the finality of Prophet-hood (Khatam-e-Nabuwwat) of Hazrat Muhammad (ﷺ). Any person who believes in any prophet in any capacity after Hazrat Muhammad (ﷺ) is outside the pale of Islam, thus, rendering all the factions of Ahmadiyya...

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
