FAITH IN THE FINALITY OF PROPHETHOOD (KHATM-E-NABUWWAT)

Beginning from Hazrat Adam عليه السلام, the chain of Prophethood ends at Prophet Muhammad ﷺ who is the Last Prophet. Allah has mentioned in the Qur'an:



مَا كَانَ مُحَمَّدٌ أَبَا أَحَدٍ مِّن رِّجَالِكُمْ وَلَكِن رَّسُولَ اللَّهِ وَخَاتَمَ النَّبِيِّينَ ط

“Muhammed is not the father of any man among you – but he is the Noble Rasool of Allah and the Last of the Prophets.” (Al-Ahzab: 40)

Previous Prophets were also given holy books and scriptures, but their followers did not care for their safety and integrity, and hence they were not preserved in their original forms.

When Allah Almighty sent the Holy Qur'an to His beloved Prophet ﷺ, He made special arrangements to make His Word secure till the Last Day as there will be no prophet after Prophet Muhammad ﷺ. And Allah's last, complete and universal message is aimed at the entire mankind until the Last Day. Allah Himself has taken the responsibility of protecting and conserving the Holy Qur'an for all time to come, and there remains no need to send any more prophets after Prophet Muhammad ﷺ.



The faith in Prophet Muhammad ﷺ makes it necessary for all Muslims to believe that he is the Last Prophet and after him there will be no prophet at all. One, who believes that there will be a prophet after him, is a 'Kafir' (unbeliever). Allah's Prophet ﷺ has told us that there will be no messenger from Allah after him. (Bukhari & Muslim)



Why has Allah taken the responsibility of protecting the Qur'an upon himself?

He also said, 'In my Ummah, thirty liars will appear and each of them will falsely claim to be a prophet. However, I am the Last Prophet and there is no prophet after me.'

(Musnad Ahmad)

It is Satan's desire to make mischief with Islam. For this purpose, he aims to entirely remove the love of Prophet Muhammad ﷺ from the hearts of Muslims. Hence Satan has been presenting false prophets to this world one after another.

A man called Musailma Kazzab fell into Satan's trap and claimed to be Allah's prophet. Sahabah decided to put him to death as it is the obligation of every Muslim to protect the faith in the finality of the Prophethood, and the penalty for the one, who claims to be a prophet after Prophet Muhammad ﷺ, is death and only death. The caliph at that time, Hazrat Abu Bakr ؓ sent

troops led by Hazrat Khalid bin Waleed ؓ to eliminate Musailma Kazzab who had gathered a big army of his followers. Musailma's army was defeated and he was killed. This was the battle of Yamama.

Before Pakistan was created in 1947 as a Muslim country in the south Asian subcontinent, the British hatched many conspiracies against Muslims. They wanted to remove from their hearts the love and respect for their beloved Prophet Muhammad ﷺ. In 1891, under the patronage of the British, Mirza Ghulam Ahmad, a liar from the town of Qadian, made the false claim that he was Allah's prophet, and his followers claimed to be Muslims. Eventually, on 7th September 1974, a law was passed in Pakistan to declare that no Qadiani can claim himself to be a Muslim because one who believes in the Prophethood of anyone after Prophet Muhammad ﷺ becomes a 'Kafir'.
